### **Additional Notes Regarding WVBG Summer Nature Camp**

**Camper Cell Phone Policy:** Campers will not be allowed to use their cell phones during camp. We will collect them at the beginning of the day and give them back at the end. If for some reason they need to call you, they can ask us and we'll set up an appropriate time for them to do so. **Being Outside:** Campers will spend the majority of the day (if not all day) outside. We will have a canopy for cover during some activities, but much of the time will be spent exploring the meadows, woodlands, etc. Campers should come prepared to spend the day outdoors. We will send you a list of suggestions for preparing campers prior to camp. If the weather is particularly stormy or otherwise dangerous, we have a small indoor space to bring campers.

**Restrooms:** We have one port-a-jon on site that campers can use as needed. We also have access to a flush toilet in a building adjacent to the WVBG that will only be accessible at select times during camp.

**Possessions:** Please mark camper's name on any possessions that are brought to camp.

**Lunches:** Please do not pack items in lunches or snacks that require refrigeration. Campers will carry their lunches in their packs until lunch time at noon.
